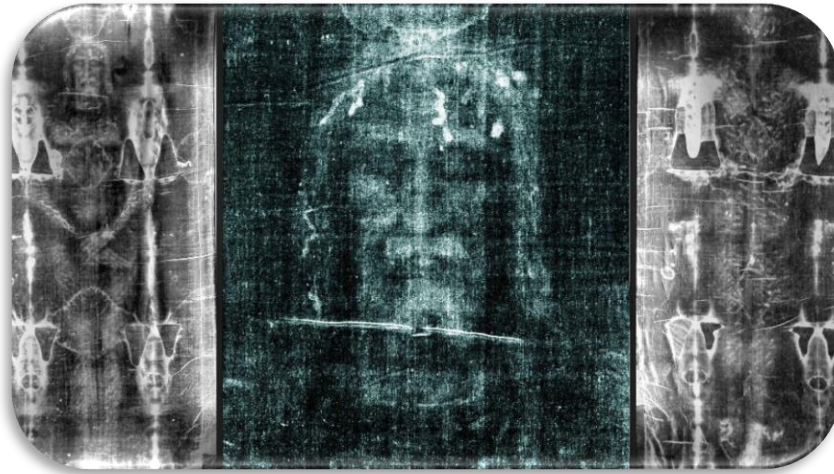


The Shroud of Turin
